In accordance with Laws and Regulations on Animal and Plant Quarantine of the PRC, and the Implementation of the International Plant Protection Convention Standard for Wood Packaging Material WPM (ISPM 15 - Guidelines for regulating wood packaging material in international trade), Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection, and Quarantine (AQSIQ) made the following requirements for WPM when entering China: 1. The WPM must undergo heat treatment, fumigation or other effective treatment recognized by China authorities before exports. The official quarantine authority of the exporting country should issue an approved IPPC logo; 2. Importers or their agents shall apply for inspection to the AQSIQ, and submit Plant Health Certificate or a Non Wood Packing Declaration. AQSIQ shall conduct sampling examination and quarantine in accordance with ISPM 15 guidelines; 3. WPM which meet the requirements shall be issued Customs Clearance Bill of Entry, which will be examined by the Customs and given customs clearance. Otherwise, WPM shall be treated with detestation by importers under the supervision of the AQSIQ, or shall be returned along with the goods.
